**Theme:** Management is not only to make clear, to deliberate and to make plans. It is also, and maybe essentially so, a more fundamentally generic work concerning competences and liberties so that the unexpected may be tackled and exploited. This is a balance to strike, but in Crisis Management the perspective of surprise may come to dominate. This is well known in principle, but the conclusions of this fact must also be drawn into real Crisis Management and into the work done in preparation for the management of crisis situations in different areas.

This is what Professor Larrasquet writes about. He is both an eminent researcher and a successful consultant. He is also a powerful organizer of international projects and conferences. His major work «*Le Management à l'épreuve du Complexe*» volumes I-II, Harmattan (1999) may be of special interest for this event. The seminar will be a unique occasion to share Mr. Larrasquet's management research and to do it (in English) in an informal and personal way.
